

## FCC Reopening

### SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Please stay home if you have been feeling ill, particularly with a fever, cough, sore throat and/or persistent headaches.
- Social distancing will be expected from the time you arrive on the property until you leave. There will be yellow dots inside to remind you to keep at least 6 feet of separation between you and the nearest person.
- In the sanctuary, the distance between rows has been increased. Please do your best to spread out amongst the seats—at least 3 chairs apart from other individuals in the same row and staggered from the people in front of and behind you. (Members of the same household can sit together.)
- Masks or facial coverings must be worn at all times, covering the mouth and nose. If you forget yours, we can provide one for you.
- Please refrain from hugging, handshaking, or other physical contact.
- Doors and windows may be kept open (depending on the weather) for air circulation. You may want to bring a jacket and/or blanket with you to stay warm.
- Hand sanitizer is available at multiple locations spread throughout the building. Please feel free to use these as you come in and leave the building.
- Feel free to enter the building using any of the main doors. If you are physically able to, however, please leave using the front double doors. This will prevent bottle-necking at the back stairway.
- Wheelchair access will be available for no more than 2 people of the same household at a time. Please wait your turn if someone from another household is using it.
- For contact tracing purposes, we will enter your name on an attendance log. Please let us know if you contract COVID-19 within 2 weeks of attending one of our services so that we can make others aware of this (we will do so anonymously).
